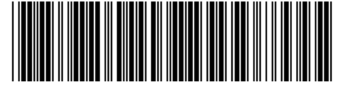

You have received this Claim Form because the parties to this litigation have discovered evidence that on _____ (the date of purchase), _____ (the purchasing municipality) paid \$ _____ (the purchase price) to either Illinois Central Railroad Company ("ICRR") or Illinois Central Gulf Railroad in return for a quitclaim deed conveying abandoned right-of-way property.

Pursuant to a Settlement Agreement between the parties in Foulke v. Illinois Central Railroad Company, the purchasing municipality may be entitled to the return of the purchase money paid for that quitclaim deed, plus interest ("settlement proceeds").

If you believe the purchasing municipality may be entitled to receive settlement proceeds you must complete this Claim Form and return it to the address at the top of this form postmarked no later than October 30, 2007. PARTICIPATION IN THE SETTLEMENT DOES NOT AFFECT YOUR OWNERSHIP RIGHTS, IF ANY, IN THE ABANDONED RIGHT-OF-WAY PROPERTY.

Finally, if you disagree with either the purchase price or the date of purchase identified above, you must provide satisfactory proof that the information is incorrect, because it may affect the total amount of settlement proceeds you are eligible to receive.
